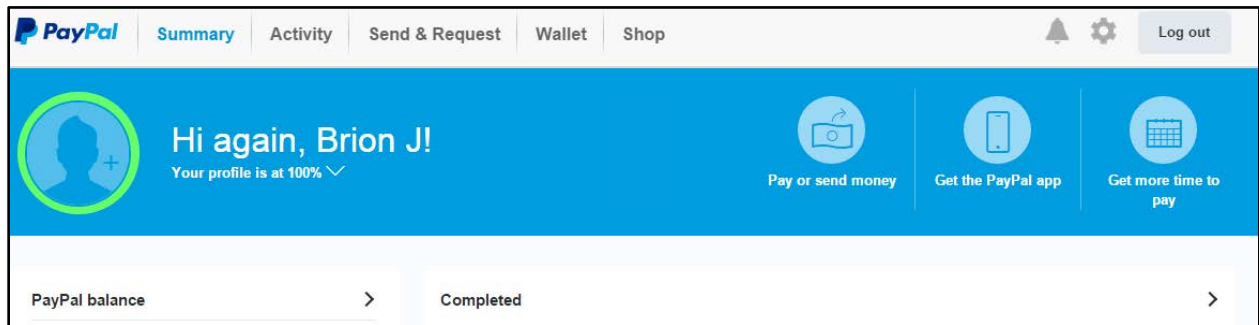


How to Make a PayPal Donation to GLMC

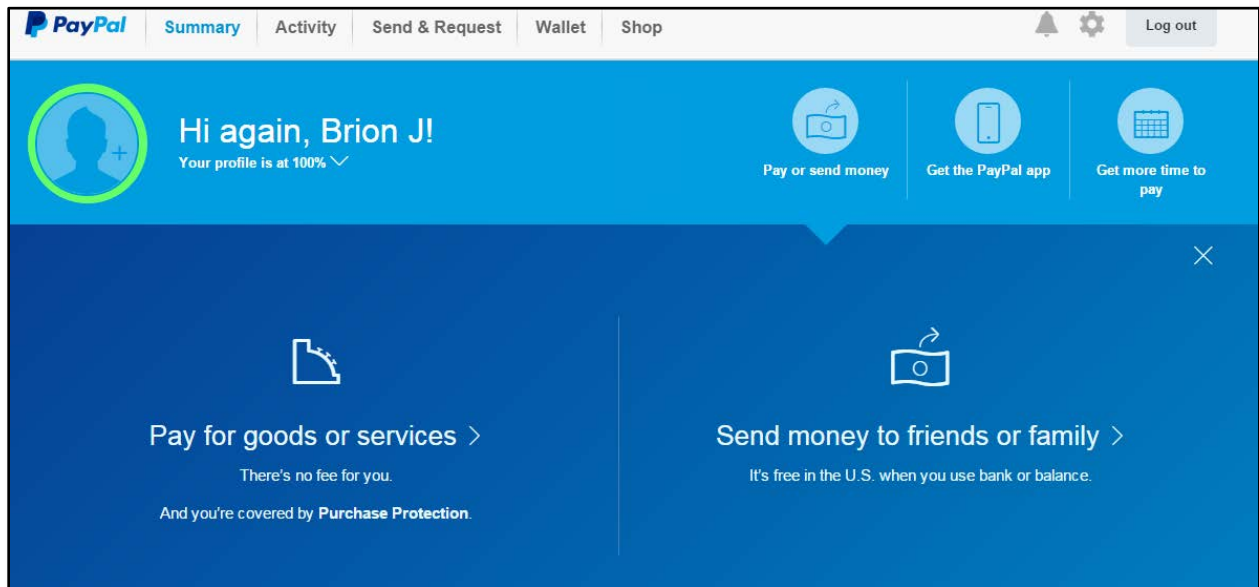
PayPal donations are a way to pay an individual or non-profit. Donations are not charged a PayPal payment fee. GLMC riders can use donations to pay for t-shirts and other items. All you need to make a donation is to have the email address of the PayPal account holder; in the case of the GLMC that email is glmc@itctel.com. Payments made by PayPal donation are not refundable via PayPal.

Note: Rally entry fees should be paid using the PayPal button on the event's page.


Log into PayPal and then click on "Pay or send money"



Nice click on "Send money to friends or family":



Enter the GLMC address (glmc@itctel.com) and the amount:


You can send to almost anyone, even if they don't have a PayPal account.




